

**FULL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF
THE “CHÂTEAU CAVALIER x DECANTER 2025 INSTAGRAM GIVEAWAY”**

Article 1 – Organising Company

CASTEL FRERES, a simplified joint-stock company (SAS) with a share capital of €78,080,619, registered with the Bordeaux Trade and Companies Register under number 482 283 694, whose registered office is located at 21/24 rue Georges Guynemer, 33295 Blanquefort Cedex, France, is organising a free Instagram contest with no purchase necessary, entitled “CHÂTEAU CAVALIER x DECANTER 2025 INSTAGRAM GIVEAWAY”, running from 12/03/2025 (12:00 p.m., French time) to 12/14/2025 (11:59 p.m., French time).

Article 2 – Conditions of Participation

This free contest with no purchase obligation is open to any natural person, excluding employees of the organising company, management and auditing companies, as well as their families.

Participation is strictly personal and nominative. Only one reimbursed participation and one winner per household (same name, same postal address, same email address) will be accepted for the entire duration of the contest.

Participation is expressly not subject to any purchase obligation.

The contest is open internationally, except in countries where local legislation prohibits participation in promotional contests or where the prize cannot be shipped.

Article 3 – Contest Procedures

The contest is open during the period from 12/03/2025 (12:00 p.m., French time) to 12/14/2025 (11:59 p.m., French time) to any participant meeting the conditions set out in Article 2 of these Rules.

Article 4 – Participation in the Contest

Participation in the contest implies full, unconditional acceptance of these Rules, all their provisions, the code of conduct applicable on the Internet, as well as all applicable laws and regulations governing games, lotteries, and contests in force in France.

To participate, entrants must:

- Connect to the Decanter and Château Cavalier Instagram pages between 12/03/2025 (12:00 p.m., French time) and 12/14/2025 (11:59 p.m., French time)
- Follow or already be following the Château Cavalier Instagram account (@chateaucavalier) and the Decanter account (@decanter);
- “Like” the contest post titled “Château Cavalier x Decanter 2025 Instagram Contest”.

Any participant who fulfils these conditions will automatically be entered into the random draw held on 12/15/2025.

Article 5 – Description and Value of the Prize

The following prize is offered:

One (1) Soundivine Magnum speaker engraved with “Château Cavalier”, valued at €369.

Article 6 – Winner Selection and Prize Award

The winner is selected via a random draw.

Participants meeting the conditions of Articles 2 and 4 will be recorded, and their names listed at the end of the contest period to proceed with the draw selecting one (1) winner.

The draw will take place under the responsibility of the organising company on 15/12/2025, without the presence of participants.

Only one prize will be awarded per household (same name, postal address, and email address). Participation is exclusively via the contest module created for the occasion on the DECANTER Instagram page in collaboration with the official Château Cavalier page (see Article 4).

The winner will be contacted by Instagram message immediately after the draw to provide their personal details. If the winner fails to respond before 01/01/2026 at 11:59 p.m. (French time), the prize will not be reallocated. Any incomplete, falsified, or non-compliant information will result in disqualification and forfeiture of the prize.

If, for any reason beyond the organisers’ control, the winner is unable to claim the prize, the prize will be forfeited and will not be reassigned, and no compensation will be owed.

The prize may not give rise to any dispute, cash equivalent, exchange, or replacement. In the event of force majeure or any other circumstance beyond its control, the organising company reserves the right to substitute the prize with another of equivalent nature and value. Any costs (travel, insurance, transportation, etc.) not expressly included in the prize remain the responsibility of the winner.

Should any incident occur during the shipping of the prize, the organising company shall not be required to carry out additional investigations. The winner will receive neither the prize nor any compensation.

Any images or graphic representations of the prize are for illustration only and are not contractually binding.

Article 7 – Integrity of the Contest

Participation implies full acceptance of these Rules. Participants agree not to implement or attempt to implement any participation method that does not strictly comply with these Rules.

The organising company reserves the right to disqualify any participant who tampers with the contest or website or who violates the official Rules. The company may take legal action against anyone who attempts to defraud or harm the proper conduct of the contest. It may cancel all or part of the contest if fraud is detected, particularly computer fraud.

The organising company may conduct any verification necessary to ensure compliance with the Rules and exclude any participant involved in fraud or abuse.

It may extend, shorten, modify, or cancel the contest due to events beyond its control. If, for any reason (e.g., virus, bug, unauthorised intrusion, fraud, technical failure), the contest does not proceed as planned, the organising company may cancel, modify, or suspend it without delay and without liability.

Article 8 – Liability

With respect to the prize, the liability of the organising company is strictly limited to delivering the prize duly and validly won. The organiser declines all responsibility for incidents or accidents that may occur during use of the prize and for any dissatisfaction regarding the prize.

The organiser reminds participants of the characteristics and limitations of the Internet and declines responsibility for consequences related to participants' connection to the network.

The organiser cannot be held liable if one or more participants are unable to connect due to technical issues or network congestion.

In the event of force majeure or circumstances beyond its control requiring modification, postponement, or cancellation of the contest, the organiser cannot be held liable.

Article 9 – Participation Costs

Reimbursements are limited to one per participant (same name, same address). Postage fees will also be reimbursed at the applicable standard rate (20 g) upon request. Reimbursement will be made by bank transfer within 5–6 weeks of receipt.

Connections made via flat-rate or free-access systems (cable, ADSL, dedicated line, etc.) are not eligible for reimbursement.

Article 10 – Authorisation of Participants

The organising company is the sole recipient of personal data.

Unless otherwise indicated, participants authorise the organiser to process their names and contact details. They also authorise the organiser to use and disclose their name, surname, and address, on any medium, for communications relating to the contest, without entitling them to remuneration.

Article 11 – Availability of the Rules

Article 12 – Acceptance of the Rules

Participation in the contest implies full and unconditional acceptance of these Rules, the procedures for conducting the contest, and the organiser's final decision regarding disputes relating to the interpretation or application of the Rules.
